- Concessionally registered vehicles may require the buyer to make additional payments.
- Annual fees may apply to some Special Number Plates.
- If you have an E-Tag, you should also update your number plate with your E-Tag provider.

Under road transport legislation, it is an offence to register or renew the registration of a vehicle by a false statement or any misrepresentation or other dishonest means.

A list of fees for transfer and stamp duty are available on our website at rms.nsw.gov.au/regofees

Failing to transfer registration is an offence. An on the spot fine of at least \$101 may be applied. If the matter goes to court a fine of up to \$2,200 may be imposed.

A late fee of at least \$110 will also apply to registrations not transferred within 14 days.
